

Merit-Based

This scholarship type may require the applicant to have a certain GPA or higher in order to be considered. Refer to the scholarship's website to determine what the minimum requirement is.

Minority

Students who identify as a minority (black, Hispanic, Asian, etc.), are encouraged to apply.

LGBTQ+

Students who identify as being a part of the LGBTQ+ community are encouraged to apply. Note that this may entail disclosure in your application.

First-generation

Students who are first-generation (are the first generation in their family to attend a college or university) are encouraged to apply.

Non-traditional destinations

Students studying in non-traditional destinations are encouraged to apply. Non-traditional destinations typically include Central/South America, Eastern Europe, Africa and Asia.

Disabilities

Students who have physical or learning disabilities are encouraged to apply.

Studying languages

Students who are studying abroad and specifically studying a language are encouraged to apply for this scholarship. This would be a great opportunity for a student who is studying abroad and taking a majority of their courses administered in another language, the coursework of which is *teaching* them the language.

Veteran

Students who are also veterans are encouraged to apply.

Academic credit

This scholarship requires applicant to apply for a study abroad program or independent study that administers academic credit. Visit the scholarship organization's website to learn more about minimum credit requirements.

Location Specific

May requires students to study abroad in a specific country. Refer to the scholarship organization's website to learn more.

Undergraduate

This scholarship is open to undergraduate students.

Graduate

This scholarship is open to graduate students.
